The Archdiocese of San Francisco has determined that proactive measures to ensure the health and safety of the community at large during the COVID-19 health crisis are necessary. As such, the Superintendent has communicated that all schools in the San Francisco Archdiocese, including Serra, will close through March 25, 2020. This closure means that all academic, athletic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are suspended until we re-open campus on March 26, 2020. It has also been recommended that we limit and avoid large gatherings. **Therefore, we have made the determination that there will be no travel through the end of April, which includes the Robotics Team trip to Idaho.**

We understand how frustrating and disappointing this is to all of our students, the cancellation of the Idaho trip, however the health and safety of your sons and our community is the most important.

We will continue to notify you of any other changes as this situation continues to develop.
